Live Auction

Fair and firm minimum bid amounts may be announced prior to the start of bidding for each item. To enter a bid, raise your Rockaway Beach Stroll program with the number facing the auctioneer. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer will be the winning bidder. In the event of any dispute, the auctioneer will determine the winning bidder. When the auctioneer announces “Sold”, the item will pass to the highest bidder, who then assumes responsibility for and will pay full purchase price, this evening, at the cashier’s desk.

Silent Auction

Fair and firm minimum bid amounts are indicated on the item bid sheet. To bid, enter your bidder number on the item bid sheet. Each new bid must exceed the previous bid by the stated bid increment. The Silent Auction will close at 4:30p. **Must be present to win.**

Payment and Receipt

Payments for all Live and Silent Auction items must be made in full by cash, check, or Credit Card (Mastercard or Visa accepted). Please make checks payable to Pacifica Resource Center/Tides Center. All items must be claimed, paid for, and removed from the auction site by the end of the evening. All sales are final. No exchanges or refunds are possible.
